**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$215,000.00 FOR A GRANT RELATED TO EXPANDING ACCESS TO ASTHMA SELF-MANAGEMENT EDUCATION IN SCHOOLS, WORKSITES AND HOMES FOR A TERM ENDING AUGUST 31, 2020 AND AUTHORIZING A PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.**

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**WHEREAS**, the SA Kids BREATHE (SAKB) program was created with the South Texas Asthma Coalition and is funded by the City of San Antonio to address high hospitalization rates in children with asthma; and

**WHEREAS**, the intended purpose of the program is to improve the lives of children with asthma by increasing school attendance and improving the management of asthma; and

**WHEREAS**, the SAKB program is a free program whose primary goal is to improve quality of life for children diagnosed with asthma by teaching them and their family best practices to control asthma; and

**WHEREAS**, the SAKB program will help keep kids out of the hospital, keep kids in school, keep parents at work, and save families and healthcare systems money; and

**WHEREAS**, SAKB Community Health Workers serve children between the ages of 3 and 17 diagnosed with asthma and residing within the city of San Antonio limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) expressed interest in funding the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District to expand the work of SAKB; and

**WHEREAS**, DSHS requested the documents be returned by September 26, 2019 and was submitted on September 26, 2019 with authorization from a Special Category Grant Opportunity form; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial term of the grant contract is expected to be approximately nine months for a term ending on August 31, 2020; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee is hereby authorized to accept funds from the Texas Department of State Health Services in an amount not to exceed \$215,000.00 for a grant related to expanding access to asthma self-management education in schools, worksites and homes for a term ending August 31, 2020.

**SECTION 2. [FINANCIAL LANGUAGE PENDING].**

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
