City would be responsible for a pro-rata share of indebtedness if it annexes territory within the ESD

No plans to annex territory within ESD No. 2

# Staff Review

City Planning, Fire and Finance staff reviewed request for impact to the City



## Recommendation

Staff recommends providing consent to ESD No. 2 to incur debt of up to \$30,000,000 to carry out their capital improvement plan and the purchase of equipment



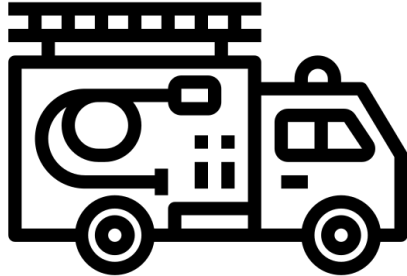

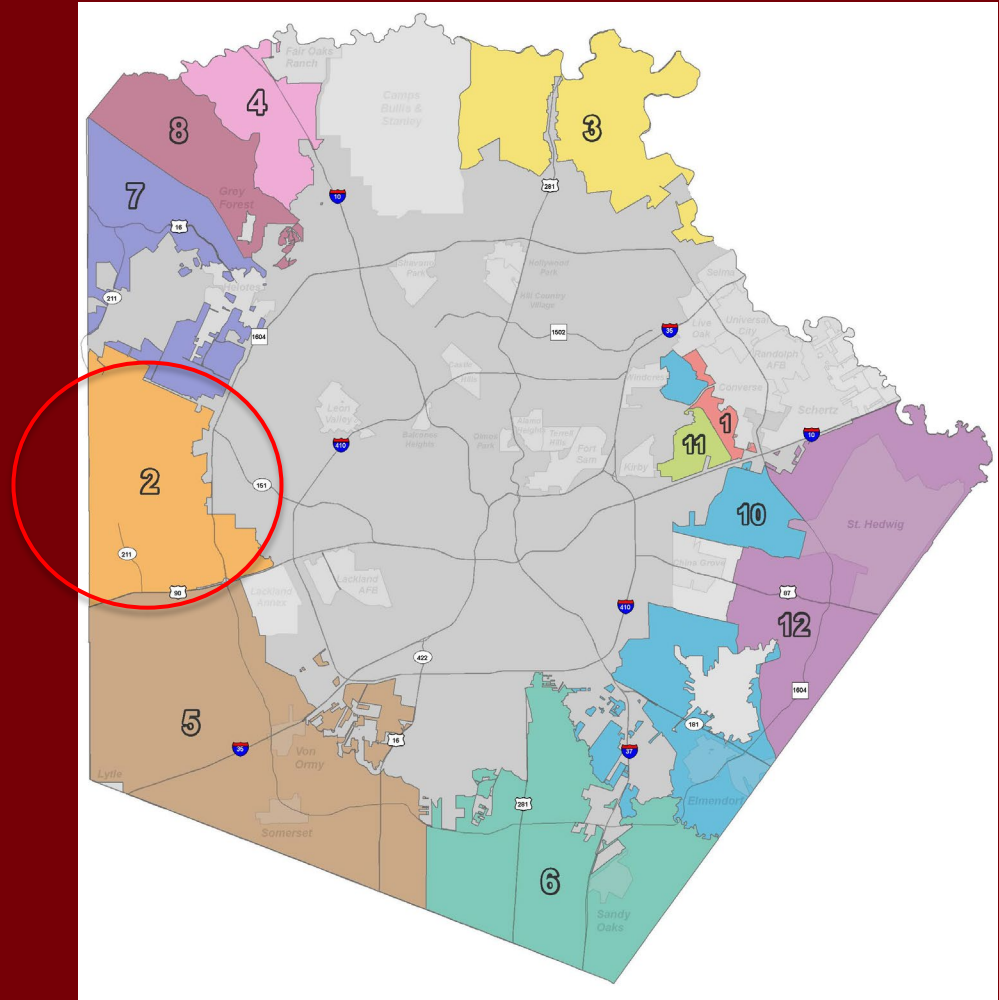
# Emergency Service Districts

Created under state law and approved by voters to provide emergency services in unincorporated areas of the County

# Emergency Service Districts

Must receive City's approval if the ESD to be located within the ETJ

City negotiated certain conditions for approval



## **ESD No. 2 - Agreement**

Cannot incur debt over \$20,000  
without consent

Must ensure equipment compatibility

Must enter into mutual aid  
agreements
