

AN ORDINANCE **2016-09-15-0707**

**AUTHORIZING THE FIRST ONE YEAR RENEWAL OF TWO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS FOR STANDBY LANDFILL COMPLIANCE, ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION AND CONSULTING SERVICES WITH DRASH CONSULTANTS, LLC, AND STEARNS, CONRAD, AND SCHMIDT, CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC., DBA SCS ENGINEERS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$165,000.00 FOR EACH FIRM DURING THE TERM OF THE RENEWAL, FOR VARIOUS CLOSED CITY LANDFILLS AND OTHER ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE PROJECTS CITY WIDE, FUNDED BY THE SOLID WASTE OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE FUND AND THROUGH ALLOCATIONS FROM SPECIFIC PROJECT FUNDS AT THE TIME WORK IS REQUIRED**

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**WHEREAS**, due to the highly regulated nature of environmental activities, and the quantity of work, it is necessary to hire consultants for environmental assessment, testing, and reporting on various, as yet to be named, projects for landfill and environmental compliance to be used on an as needed basis; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2015-10-01-0847 authorized the execution of two professional service agreements with Drash Consultants, LLC, and Stearns, Conrad, and Schmidt, Consulting Engineers, Inc., dba SCS Engineers, to provide technical assistance to the Solid Waste Management Department for various landfill and environmental activities, including groundwater monitoring, landfill gas monitoring and repairs, leachate collection, permit modifications, and performing site assessments, with a contract term for one year, through September 30, 2016, with two additional optional one year terms; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance authorizes the first one year renewal of two professional services agreements with Drash Consultants, LLC, and Stearns, Conrad, and Schmidt, Consulting Engineers, Inc., dba SCS Engineers, under identical terms and conditions, for standby landfill compliance, environmental remediation and consulting services, in an amount not to exceed \$165,000.00 for each firm during the term of the renewal, funded by the Solid Waste Operating and Maintenance Fund and through allocations from specific project funds at the time the work is required; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The professional services contracts with Drash Consultants, LLC, and Stearns, Conrad, and Schmidt, Consulting Engineers, Inc., dba SCS Engineers, are hereby renewed for the first one-year renewal period, starting October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017, under identical terms and conditions, for standby landfill compliance, environmental remediation and consulting services, in an amount not to exceed \$165,000.00 for each firm during the term of the renewal, funded by the Solid Waste Operating and Maintenance Fund and through allocations from specific project funds at the time the work is required.

**SECTION 2.** Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$330,000.00 is contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget for Fund 55001000, Cost Center 5556020001 and General Ledger 5201040.

**SECTION 3.** If approved by council, payment not to exceed \$165,000.00 is authorized to Drash Consultants, LLC, and \$165,000.00 is authorized to Stearns, Conrad, and Schmidt Consulting Engineers, Inc., dba SCS Engineers, and funds should be encumbered with a purchase order. Payments shall be made on an as-needed basis.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


