WHEREAS, Eckhert Village, Ltd. has proposed a 80 unit affordable rental housing development located at the northeast corner of Bandera Road and Eckert Road in Council District 7 named Eckhert Village, in the City of San Antonio, Texas, County of Bexar; and

WHEREAS, Eckhert Village, Ltd. has advised that it intends to submit an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) for 2014 Competitive 9% Housing Tax Credits for the Eckhert Village development; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to support the proposed Eckhert Village development;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. It is hereby confirmed that the City supports the proposed Eckhert Village development located at the northeast corner of Bandera Road and Eckert Road in the City of San Antonio, Texas, and that this formal action has been taken to put on record the opinion expressed by the City of San Antonio on March 20, 2014.




