AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT INCREASING COMPENSATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,260,000.00 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THC, INC. FOR MANAGEMENT OF THE RESIDENTIAL ACOUSTICAL TREATMENT PROGRAM AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program is an on-going program of acoustical treatment to reduce noise in qualifying homes and multi-family dwellings; and

WHEREAS, THC, Inc, has managed the Program on behalf of the City pursuant to a Professional Services Agreement previously approved by City Council and the proposed amendment would increase the sum paid to this firm for management of the Program and construction of related improvements, by \$7,260,000.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for the Management of the Acoustical Treatment Program at San Antonio International Airport with the firm of THC, Inc., a copy of which is set out in **Exhibit 1**.

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount of \$7,260,000.00, in SAP Fund 51099000, Airport Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 33-00170, Residential Acoustical Treatment Program, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to THC, Inc., for professional services.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
