










# Project Scope

- An Ordinance authorizing an Interlocal Agreement between The City of San Antonio and San Antonio Water Systems (SAWS), allowing SAWS to provide sampling services for compliance of the ban on coal tar sealant pavement products
- Reimbursements will be made monthly to SAWS depending on materials and services, in an amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) annually, available from the Storm Water Operations Fund.






# Project Scope

## **City shall perform and provide the following:**

- Documentation and research regarding possible instances/locations of coal tar sealant pavement product usage
- Upon discovery of possible usage of coal tar sealant pavement product usage, City shall request from the property owner for documentation if that has not been provided the City shall direct SAWS to those usage sites for SAWS's testing and sampling.
- If/When coal tar sealant pavement product usage is confirmed, based on test results on samples collected by SAWS and sent to a certified lab (and/or sub-consulting lab) of SAWS's choosing, City shall address all enforcement options afforded to it, to include citizen notification.




# Project Scope

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## **SAWS shall perform and/or provide the following:**


- Within thirty (30) days of said identification, SAWS representatives shall proceed to the City-identified location(s) and conduct on-site field tests on the identified possible coal tar sealant pavement product.
- SAWS shall sample as many locations within the identified site as SAWS deems necessary, collecting samples for off-site laboratory testing.
- Upon collecting the necessary on-site field samples as necessary, SAWS shall send the collected field samples to a certified laboratory
- SAWS shall forward said laboratory test verification results to City for any necessary action then to be undertaken by City



# Project Schedule

- Agreement effective January 1, 2017 when the Ordinance is enacted.
- Investigations and testing will begin January 1, 2017 as locations are identified





# Summary of Recommended Actions

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- Staff recommends approval of the Interlocal Agreement between the City of San Antonio and SAWS for the testing of coal tar sealant pavement products.
