1.1 **Conduct Activities that Result in the Arrest, Clearance, and Recoveries of Motor Vehicle Theft**

ABTPA Task force members will conduct salvage yard, used car dealer, and repair shop inspections. Through this effort, the task force members will locate stolen vehicles and stolen vehicle parts. Task force members will conduct surveillance of suspected auto theft offenders and locations. The task force will use social media outlets to conduct sting operations of possible auto theft suspects. The task force will utilize the Unit's License Plate Reader Vehicle on a continuous basis to identify stolen vehicles. All these strategies are devised to reduce the attractiveness of dealing in stolen vehicles and parts by swift enforcement and apprehension of offenders thereby reducing the actual crime

Task force members will also conduct warrant round up operations in conjunction with the Bexar County Sheriff's Warrant Task Force in an effort to arrest prolific burglary of a vehicle wanted suspects.

Task force members will attempt to identify and recover stolen vehicle parts while conducting business inspections of salvage yards, repair shops, metal recyclers, and resale locations.

Task force member will conduct vehicle GPS operations that target vehicle burglary offenders.
