

ORDINANCE 2019-05-16-0420

AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO BY AMENDING CHAPTER 35, UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE, SECTION 35-304, OF THE CITY CODE OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS BY CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY OF CERTAIN PROPERTY.

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**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held after notice and publication regarding this amendment to the Official Zoning Map at which time parties in interest and citizens were given an opportunity to be heard; and

**WHEREAS**, the Zoning Commission has submitted a final report to the City Council regarding this amendment to the Official Zoning Map of the City of San Antonio; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 35, Unified Development Code, Section 35-304, Official Zoning Map, of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is amended by changing the zoning district boundary of Lot P-58B and Lot P-58D, NCB 12867 from "RM-4 MLOD-3 MLR-1 MSAO-2 AHOD" Residential Mixed Martindale Army Airfield Military Lighting Overlay District Military Lighting Region 1 Martindale Army Airfield Military Sound Attenuation Overlay Airport Hazard Overlay District and "C-2 MLOD-3 MLR-1 MSAO-2 AHOD" Commercial Martindale Army Airfield Military Lighting Overlay District Military Lighting Region 1 Martindale Army Airfield Military Sound Attenuation Overlay Airport Hazard Overlay District to "C-3 MLOD-3 MLR-1 MSAO-2 AHOD" General Commercial Martindale Army Airfield Military Lighting Overlay District Military Lighting Region 1 Martindale Army Airfield Military Sound Attenuation Overlay Airport Hazard Overlay District.

**SECTION 2.** All other provisions of Chapter 35 except those expressly amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect including the penalties for violations as made and provided for in Section 35-491.

**SECTION 3.** The Director of Development Services shall change the zoning records and maps in accordance with this ordinance and the same shall be available and open to the public for inspection.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective May 26, 2019.


