

AN ORDINANCE 2014 - 09 - 04 - 0646

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BEXAR COUNTY FOR ACCEPTANCE OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$8,500,000.00 TO INCORPORATE THE COUNTY'S BARBARA DRIVE DRAINAGE PROJECT (SA-3) INTO THE CITY'S BARBARA DRIVE DRAINAGE PROJECT FOR THE CITY TO PROVIDE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, AND PROPERTY ACQUISITION SERVICES FOR BOTH PROJECTS LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 1.

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WHEREAS, as a result of the devastating floods of 1998 and 2002, Bexar County voters approved the Bexar County Flood Control Program which is funded by a flood control tax collected by Bexar County from all residents and business located within Bexar County; and

WHEREAS, the Barbara Drive Drainage Project (SA-3) is part of the Bexar County Flood Control Program and is located within the San Antonio city limits, in the Shearer Hills and Ridgeview neighborhood between McCullough Avenue and Skipper Drive; and

WHEREAS, this community has experienced many flooding problems since the 1950's, resulting in the City of San Antonio funding two capital projects in the neighborhood to alleviate some of the flooding issues, however, the flooding problems continue to exist and in May 2013, the neighborhood experienced a severe flood on Memorial Day weekend; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County have agreed to incorporate the Bexar County SA-3 Project into the City's Barbara Drive Project, a \$2,950,000.00 FY 2014 Storm Water Regional Fund Project which was approved by City Council to increase the funding for the Bexar County SA-3 Project as a result of an expanded project scope due to the May 2013 flood event; and

WHEREAS, The combined project will consist of removing the existing concrete channel and underground box culvert drainage system east of McCullough Avenue and replacing the existing drainage system with a wider and deeper earthen channel to convey the 1% annual chance (100-year) ultimate design storm; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary design is an earthen channel that requires the acquisition of approximately 36 residential properties; and

WHEREAS, several public meetings were held to inform the community of the potential property acquisitions along the south side of Barbara Drive and the north side of Shannon Lee between McCullough Avenue and Skipper Drive and the vast majority have already voiced their support of the acquisitions due to past flooding issues, several of these properties were most recently flooded in May 2013.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with Bexar County to incorporate the Bexar County SA-3 Project within the City's Barbara Drive Drainage Project and to authorize acceptance of funds in the not-to-exceed amount of \$8,500,000.00 from Bexar County for the completion of the Barbara Drive Drainage Project, including the design and construction management as well as the property acquisitions; and

WHEREAS, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of Council's policy to collaborate and coordinate with other governmental agencies in supporting the City's commitment to maintaining and improving existing infrastructure; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with Bexar County for acceptance of an amount not to exceed \$8,500,000.00 to incorporate the County's Barbara Drive Drainage Project (SA-3) into the City's Barbara Drive Drainage Project for the City to provide design, construction management, and property acquisition services for both projects. The Agreement must be executed by all parties within 90 days of signing of this Ordinance; otherwise, the Agreement must be considered through a subsequent Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funds are authorized to be received from Bexar County to SAP Fund 40099000, Other Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-01398, Barbara Drive Area Drainage, and the budget shall be revised by increasing WBS element 23-01398-90-10-01, Bexar County Contribution and SAP General Ledger 4502280, Contribution from other Agencies, in the amount of \$8,500,000.00.
- b) The amount of \$8,500,000.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 40099000, Other Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-01398, Barbara Drive Area Drainage, SAP WBS Element 23-01398-05-02-05, Construction-Bexar County and SAP General Ledger 5201245.
- c) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
