An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

Unit 450011 Vermeer 7000 series Tub grinder suffered unforeseen damage and will need a new engine, this grinder supports the City of San Antonio's Bitters brush site's brush grinding program, this unit is needed to grind heavy brush that is delivered to the site daily and to keep brush from becoming a fire hazard which poses a threat to public health and safety. We cannot afford to bid this out as there is only one Cat c27 engine available and if it is purchased it is possible for the next engine to take months to build and make available for our machine. Due to the volume of brush we cannot afford to move a grinder from another location as the demand is the same at both brush sites, also moving this type of equipment causes issues as it needs to be setup and poses potential damage when being transported. Rental for this type of equipment is very unlikely due to the high cost of the machinery which also requires expensive routine maintenance. Currently the Bitters brush site is bringing in 2400-3000 tons of Brush weekly.
