**RESOLUTION NO.**

**RECOMMENDING TO APPROVE AN AMENDMENT TO THE MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN, A COMPONENT OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MASTER PLAN BY REALIGNING A PROPOSED SEGMENT OF TALLEY ROAD, A SECONDARY ARTERIAL TYPE A REQUIRING 86 FEET OF RIGHT-OF-WAY, BETWEEN CULEBRA ROAD (FM 471) AND CARTWRIGHT TRAIL, GENERALLY LOCATED IN WESTERN BEXAR COUNTY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission is charged by the City Charter with the responsibility to make, amend, extend, and add to the City of San Antonio Master Plan for the physical growth and development of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Antonio Major Thoroughfare Plan was adopted on September 21, 1978 by City Council as a component of the City of San Antonio Master Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission held public hearings on May 23, 2018 allowing all interested citizens to be heard.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**


**SECTION 1:** The amendment to the Major Thoroughfare Plan, a component of the Master Plan of the City, is herein approved and recommended to City Council for adoption to:

- 1) Realigning a proposed segment of Talley Rad, a Secondary Arterial Type A requiring 86 feet of right-of-way, between Culebra Road (FM 471) and Cartwright Trail.

The Amendment is more particularly described in **Attachment "A,"** attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.
