- provide a 50 foot buffer along the back side of their property
- provide a solid wood fence along Milsa
- provide a rod iron fence with masonry along the backside of their property
- limit the units that will face the neighborhood to 3 stories with no balconies
- fully enclose their dumpsters

<u>James Griffin</u>, representative, stated he has working with representatives from Friends of Friedrich Wilderness Park and have agreed on the same conditions as stated by Mr. Brown. He further stated there were a few conditions requested by Friends of Friedrich Wilderness Park such as

- limiting pedestrian access on the north south and west side of the park
- Restriction on outdoor cats at the apartment complex.
- Restriction on feeding of feral cats
- All on site
