This Certificate of Exemption is executed and filed with the Finance Department as follows:

1. The undersigned is authorized to approve an exemption.
2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

Labor Relations Issue #17-64 follows protocols set forth in CBA 2016-2021, Articles 9 - 10, for the specification review of equipment. It was agreed under Labor Relations Issue #17-64 that the Honda Goldwing GL 1800 shall be selected for the replacement of police motorcycles. There are currently 18 Honda Goldwing GL1800 motorcycles in active service; and 3 spare motorcycles of the same model. There are 5 2020 BMW R1250RT police motorcycles in service, but SAPD Fleet has given direction that this make and model will no longer be pursued. Labor Relations Issue #17-64 will stand for future purchases. The proposed annual contract shall provide motorcycle replacements in FY 2021 (6) and FY 2022 (6) for an total estimate of 12 motorcycles. The proposed contract may also supply additional motorcycles as needed for accident replacements, pending appropriated funds.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with Any Honda Dealer which will cost approximately \$ 390,103.00.
