BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Building Standards Board (BSB) is a citizen-based board and includes ten members appointed by the Mayor and each Councilmember and three (3) are appointed at-large. The BSB will consist of two panels of seven (7) members which will hear and rule on appeals to and violations of the San Antonio Property Maintenance Code (SAPMC) and cases related to the repair or demolition of unsafe structures.

The at-large appointments will be selected for the Commercial Rental Property Manager and Historic Preservation Professional Categories.

The Applicants selected will serve the remainder of unexpired terms of office to expire May 31, 2015. The recommendation of the Quality of Life Council Committee will be brought forth to the full City Council on November 21, 2013.
