

AN ORDINANCE **2017-02-09-0068**

ORDERING THE GENERAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 6, 2017, AND A RUN-OFF ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, JUNE 10, 2017, IF NECESSARY; AND SETTING FORTH ELECTION PROCEDURES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. ELECTION ORDERED. The San Antonio City Council orders a General Municipal Election be held on Saturday, the 6th day of May, 2017, in accordance with all applicable laws of the State of Texas, including but not limited to the Texas Election Code, and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, for the purpose of electing the City's Mayor and Council. There shall be eleven offices designated on the ballot as follows:

Member of Council, Place 1
Member of Council, Place 2
Member of Council, Place 3
Member of Council, Place 4
Member of Council, Place 5
Member of Council, Place 6
Member of Council, Place 7
Member of Council, Place 8
Member of Council, Place 9
Member of Council, Place 10
Member of Council, Place 11 (Mayor)

SECTION 2. JOINT ELECTION. The City Council also authorizes the May 6, 2017 General Election to be held jointly with other participating local political subdivisions located within Bexar County. The city shall execute an agreement with Bexar County to conduct the election as a joint election with the other political subdivisions identified in the agreement, at a future meeting.

Pursuant to the Texas Election Code, Section 61.012, as amended, the Bexar County Elections Administrator shall provide at least one accessible voting system in each polling place used in the election. The voting system shall comply with Texas and federal laws establishing the requirements for voting systems that permit voters with physical disabilities to cast a confidential or secret ballot.

SECTION 3. PRECINCTS AND POLLING LOCATIONS; HOURS OF VOTING. The General Election shall be held as prescribed by law between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 6, 2017, at the precincts of the City of San Antonio at the locations listed by the Bexar County Elections Administration office. The list of locations will be attached to the election agreement when brought for approval.

SECTION 4. VOTING SYSTEM. Voting on Election Day, Saturday, May 6, 2017, shall be conducted by the use of AIS650 Tabulators, paper ballots, or the iVotronic™ touch screen voting system, as determined by the City Clerk and the Bexar County Elections Administrator.

For early voting by mail and for provisional voting at this election, the City Clerk has determined that voting shall be conducted by the use of the AIS650 Tabulators, and paper ballots.

For early voting by personal appearance, beginning on Monday, April 24, 2017, and ending on Tuesday, May 2, 2017, the City Clerk has determined that voting shall be conducted by the use of the iVotronic™ touch screen voting system. The equipment shall be placed at branch offices established for the purpose of conducting early voting by personal appearance at the locations and during the dates and hours listed by the Bexar County Elections Administration, in an attachment to the election agreement brought to Council for consideration at a later meeting.

SECTION 5. EARLY VOTING. Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the branch offices during the period for early voting, commencing Monday, April 24, 2017, and ending on Tuesday, May 2, 2017. Hours of early voting are established by the Bexar County Elections Administrator in accordance with the applicable provisions of Texas law. A copy of the locations and hours for early voting are attached as **Exhibit A**.

Electors may cast their early vote by mail. Ballot applications and ballots voted by mail shall be mailed to the early voting clerk as follows:

The last day to receive an application for a ballot to be voted by mail is Tuesday, April 25, 2017.

SECTION 6. NOTICE. (a) *Form of Notice of Election.* The City Clerk of the City of San Antonio is authorized and directed to prepare a form of the Notice of Election in both English and Spanish, the contents of which comply with the requirements of Section 4.004 of the Texas Election Code and any other applicable law, and will include at the minimum, the nature and date of the election; the location of each election day and early voting polling place; the hours the polls will be open; the locations, dates and times of temporary branch locations of early voting by personal appearance; the early voting clerk's mailing address; and any other information required by other law, and with variations as permitted by applicable law.

(b) *Method of Giving Notice.* Notice of the election shall be given by posting a copy of the Notice of Election, both in English and Spanish, not later than the 21st day before the date set for the election on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council of the City. Notice of the election shall also be given by publishing said Notice of Election, both in English and Spanish, at least once, not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day before Election Day, in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio. The City Council declares that the *San Antonio Express News* is a newspaper of general circulation within the city.

SECTION 7. CONTRACT FOR ELECTION SERVICES. The City Council will contract with the Bexar County Elections Administrator to conduct this election. The Council shall consider and approve this contract at a future meeting by passage of an ordinance.


SECTION 8. ELECTION MATERIAL. All resident qualified electors of the City shall be permitted to vote at the election and on the day of the election, such electors shall vote at the designated polling places. The election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, as amended, and as may be required by any other law. All election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.

SECTION 9. CANVASS DATE. The City Council shall canvass the results of the election during the regularly scheduled "B" Session on Wednesday, May 17, 2017.

SECTION 10. DATE OF RUN-OFF. If necessary, a run-off election is ordered to be held on Saturday, June 10, 2017, in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance is effective immediately, if approved by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day from the date of passage.


