

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SHAVANO PARK, AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER TO SIGN  
THE PROPOSED MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF SHAVANO PARK, TEXAS AND THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio's municipal boundaries extends and is contiguous to the municipal boundaries of the City of Shavano Park in certain areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shavano Park submitted Resolution R-2013-03, dated December 16, 2013 requesting that the City of San Antonio swap certain municipal boundaries along the city's shared boundary lines in support of the Salado Creek Trail system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shavano Park has requested to add two separate tracts of land, approximately 6.24 acres, to its municipal boundary from the City of San Antonio and in exchange, has agreed to release one tract of land of approximately 31.81 acres to the City of San Antonio; and,


WHEREAS, at the July 28, 2014 City Council Meeting, City Council authorized the City Manager to negotiate the terms of the Municipal Boundary Adjustment Agreement and present the terms to City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to authorize the City Manager to sign the proposed Municipal Boundary Adjustment agreement which includes a \$15,000 payment to the City of San Antonio to be paid in annual installments of \$3,750.00 over the next four years; and


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHAVANO PARK TEXAS:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign the proposed Municipal Boundary Adjustment agreement which includes a \$15,000 payment to the City of San Antonio to be paid in annual installments of \$3,750.00 over the next four years.
