AN ORDINANCE

**AWARDING \$32,000.00 IN TEXAS COMMISSION ON THE ARTS
FUNDS TO LOCAL ARTS AND CULTURAL PROJECTS AND
AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS FOR THE AWARD OF SUCH FUNDS.**

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WHEREAS, the Department for Culture and Creative Development (“DCCD”) applies annually to the Texas Commission on the Arts (“TCA”) seeking funding that helps leverage the City’s local arts investment and through this process, DCCD was awarded \$32,000.00 to support local non-profit arts and cultural organizations; and

WHEREAS, in September 2013, TCA awarded San Antonio \$32,000.00 to re-grant to local non-profit arts organizations for arts and cultural projects and DCCD conducted an application process to award such funds: and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Arts Board approved preliminary funding recommendations on November 23, 2013 and final funding recommendations on November 25, 2013 which recommendations are reflected in Section 2, below; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. A total of \$32,000.00 in TCA funds are awarded to the agencies listed in Section 2 in the amounts indicated. The terms and conditions of the template Arts Agency Contract, attached to this Ordinance as **Exhibit I**, are approved and the City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute similar agreements with the agencies receiving such finding.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$32,000.00 has been appropriated in a designated fund and payment is authorized to the following agencies upon issuance of a Purchase Order:

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective ten days after its passage.
