## AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN ANTONIO RIVER AUTHORITY (SARA) TO GRANT SARA ACCESS TO CITY PROPERTY AND/OR RIGHTS OF WAY SO THAT THEY MAY INSTALL FLOOD MONITORING TELEMETRY RAIN GAUGES TO BE USED TO FORECAST FLOOD CONDITIONS.

**WHEREAS**, currently SARA utilizes a hydrologic and hydrodynamic modeling application (FloodWorks) to provide real-time rainfall conditions and forecasted flood simulations designed to improve emergency response and flood warning systems; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2012-08-02-0562 authorized a separate Interlocal Agreement between the City's Office of Emergency Management (OEM) and SARA which provided a mechanism for sharing the information obtained through the FloodWorks system to improve emergency response and flood warning for an annual fee of \$21,300.00; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with the San Antonio River Authority to allow SARA to have access to City property and/or rights of way to facilitate the installation of flood monitoring rain gauges, as part of the FloodWorks systems, and establishes a process for approving rain gauges sites; and

**WHEREAS**, this Interlocal Agreement will work in conjunction with the existing agreement between SARA and OEM to improve emergeny response and floodwarning by improving the flood forecasting **NOW THEREFORE**,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the San Antonio River Authority. A copy of the Interlocal Agreement, in substantial form, is attached and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**. The execution authority granted by this ordinance shall expire 60 days from the effective date.

**SECTION 4.** There is no financial impact with this Ordinance.
