

AN ORDINANCE 2018-06-14-0447

AWARDING A CITY COUNCIL PROJECT FUND GRANT ALLOCATION TO THE MAGIK THEATRE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,364.54 FOR TICKETS TO ITS LITERACY PROGRAM, AS REQUESTED BY CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS TREVIÑO, SHAW, VIAGRAN, SALDAÑA, AND BROCKHOUSE.

WHEREAS, the adopted FY 2018 budget provides for individual City Council district discretionary funds, referred to as City Council Project Funds for programs, activities, events, scholarships, goods, or services that promote specified municipal public purposes set out in guidelines approved by City Council pursuant to Ordinance 2011-12-08-1011 dated December 8, 2011 and updated pursuant to Ordinance 2013-11-07-0761; and

WHEREAS, City Councilmembers Treviño, Shaw, Viagran, Saldaña and Brockhouse submitted requests for CCPF for the The Magik Theatre in the amount of \$15,364.54 in support of its Tickets to Literacy program from October 2017 through September 2018; and

WHEREAS, to date this fiscal year, The Magik Theatre has entertained and educated more than 40,000 pre-K and elementary school children at their home stage, and of those, more than 4,000 attended free through the Tickets to Literacy program, for many, their first live theatre performance; and

WHEREAS, by September 2018, The Magik Theatre will have produced eight full-scale shows based on classical and contemporary children's literature for both its home stage and the expanded outreach at the Empire Theatre, as well as brought seven unique touring performances to schools throughout San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, approval of these funds will assist in providing thousands of children access to an educational, cultural, and artistic experience that is unique in this community; and

WHEREAS, this initiative meets the objectives set out in the CCPF Guidelines and it is the desire of City Council to support and approve this request; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Funding for this ordinance in the amount up to \$15,364.54 is available as part of the FY 2018 Adopted General Fund Budget for CCPF, as depicted in the table below:

SECTION 2. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to The Magik Theatre, and shall be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.




