AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE OFFER FROM VICTOR STANLEY, INC. TO PROVIDE THE DOWNTOWN OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT WITH A VENDOR TO MANUFACTURE AND DELIVER 90 METAL RECYCLING AND TRASH RECEPTACLES FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$83,097.60, FUNDED FROM THE FY 2018 SOLID WASTE OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE FUND.

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Victor Stanley, Inc., through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (a.k.a. the “Buyboard”), to provide the City with 90 metal recycling and trash receptacles for a total cost of \$83,097.60; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 97097 on January 30, 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Victor Stanley, Inc. to provide the City with 90 metal recycling and trash receptacles for a total cost of \$83,097.60 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**.
