A request for a change in zoning from "RM-6 MSAO-1 MLOD" Residential Mixed Camp Bullis Military Sound Attenuation Overlay Camp Bullis Military Lighting Overlay District to "R-20 S MSAO-1" Residential Single-Family Camp Bullis Military Sound Attenuation Overlay Camp Bullis Military Lighting Overlay District with a Specific Use Authorization for a Wireless Communication System on 0.459 acres out of Lot 3, Block 10, NCB 18333; 18104 Babcock Road.
