AN ORDINANCE

**AMENDING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MAJOR THOROUGHFARE
PLAN, A COMPONENT OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MASTER
PLAN BY REALIGNING A PROPOSED SEGMENT OF TALLEY ROAD,
A SECONDARY ARTERIAL TYPE A REQUIRING 86 FEET OF RIGHT-
OF-WAY, BETWEEN CULEBRA ROAD (FM 471) AND CARTWRIGHT
TRAIL, LOCATED IN WEST BEXAR COUNTY.**

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio Major Thoroughfare Plan was adopted on September 21, 1978 by City Council as a component of the City of San Antonio Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on May 23, 2018 by the Planning Commission allowing all interested citizens to be heard: **NOW THEREFORE;**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1: The Major Thoroughfare Plan, a component of the Master Plan of the City, is amended to realign a proposed segment of Talley Road, a Secondary Arterial Type A requiring 86 feet of right-of-way, between existing Culebra Road (FM 471) and Cartwright Trail. The Amendment is more particularly described in **ATTACHMENT "A,"** attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective _____ 2018.

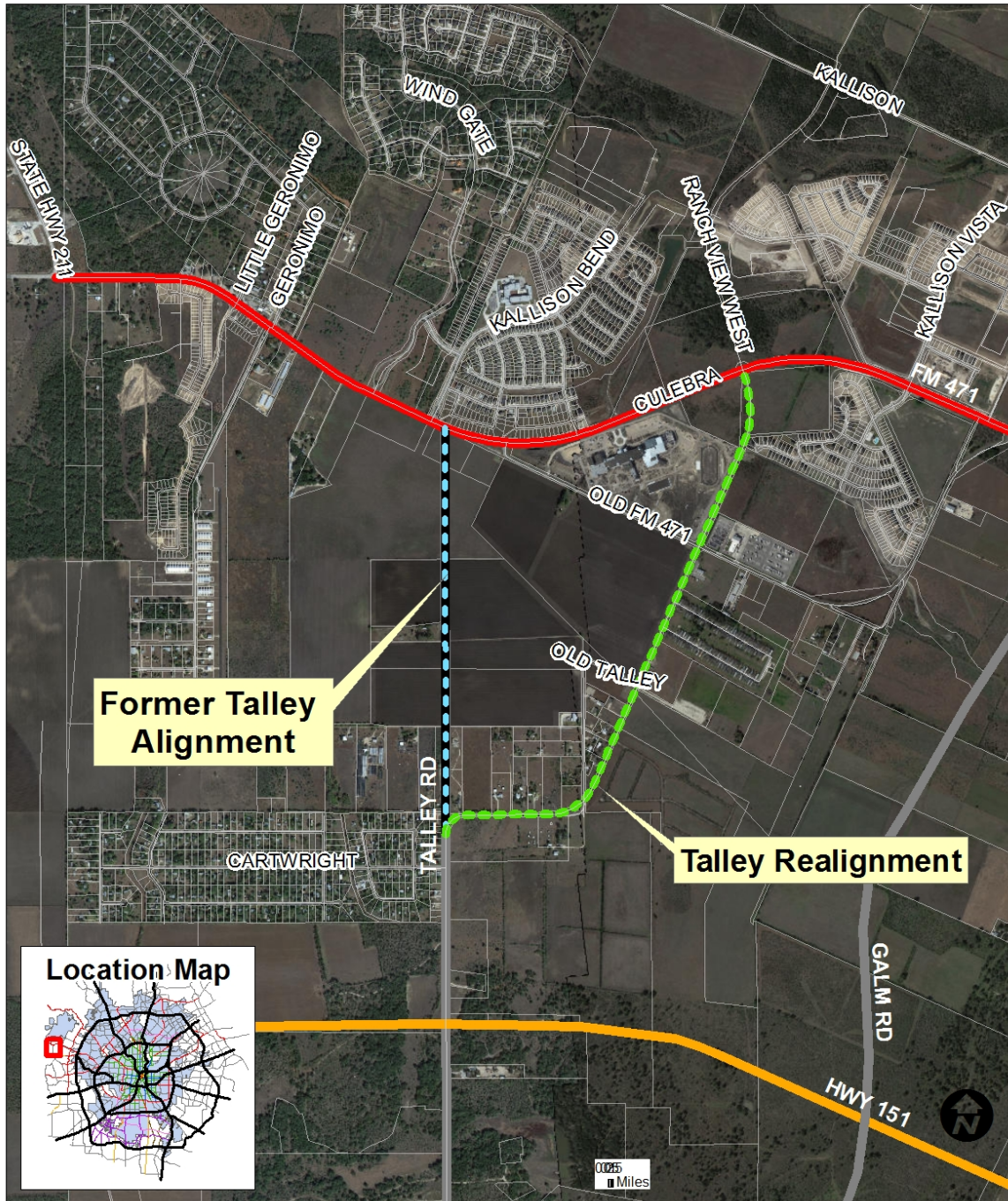
