

A RESOLUTION **2015-06-18-0042R**

**OF SUPPORT FOR THE CHEYENNE VILLAGE APARTMENTS PROJECT  
APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF TEXAS 4% TAX CREDIT PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, Cheyenne TAP, LLC, a Texas limited liability corporation (the "Applicant"), has proposed a 60 unit affordable rental housing development named Cheyenne Village Apartments (the "Development"), to be located at 147 Cheyenne Avenue, in the City of San Antonio, Texas (the "City"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Applicant has submitted an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) for 2015 Housing Tax Credits for the Development (the "Application"); and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary that the City Council provide a Resolution of Support as required by the TDHCA 2015 Housing Tax Credit Application for the Development; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City certifies in accordance with the requirements of Texas Government Code §2306.67071 and Texas Administrative Code §10.204(4), it is hereby found that:

- (i) Notice has been provided to the City in accordance with Texas Government Code, §2306.67071(a); and
- (ii) The City has had sufficient opportunity to obtain a response from the Applicant regarding any questions or concerns about the proposed Development; and
- (iii) The City has held a hearing at which public comment may be made on the proposed Development in accordance with Texas Government Code, §2306.67071(b); and
- (iv) After due consideration of the information provided by the Applicant and public comment, the City supports the proposed Application.

**SECTION 2.** That for and on behalf of the City Council, the City Clerk is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to certify this Resolution to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.


**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


