

AN ORDINANCE 2017-09-14-0659

FOR THE FY 2017 TRAFFIC SIGNAL RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$950,728.80 TO E-Z BEL CONSTRUCTION, LLC, A FY 2017 INFRASTRUCTURE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (IMP) FUNDED PROJECT, FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT FOUR INTERSECTIONS, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICTS 1, 3, 4 AND 5.

WHEREAS, the Traffic Signal portion of the Infrastructure Management Program (IMP) is used to reconstruct aging traffic signal infrastructure that has reached the end of its useful life, and the program identifies those locations which are in the greatest need of replacement to avoid repetitive high maintenance costs; and

WHEREAS, the reconstruction of the traffic signal infrastructure includes replacing older wood pole signal supports as well as very old metal pole structures with steel mast arm poles, and additionally, all traffic signal heads, vehicle detection systems, pedestrian signals, battery backup units, and internally illuminated street name signs are replaced; and

WHEREAS, these projects also reconstruct sidewalks and curb ramps when necessary to ensure that access to pedestrian signals is accessible to all users of the transportation system; and

WHEREAS, for fiscal year 2017, the following intersections were included in the Traffic Signal IMP: Main Ave. at Woodlawn Ave., in Council District 1; Military Dr. SE at Presa St. S, in Council District 3; Applewhite Rd. at Poteet Jourdanton Freeway, in Council District 4; and Gen. McMullen Dr. at Weir Ave., in Council District 5; and

WHEREAS, this Project was advertised for construction bids in July 2017 in the San Antonio Hart Beat, the City of San Antonio Bidding and Contracting Opportunities website, Texas Electronic State Business Daily, and on TVSA, and the four bids for this Project were opened on August 1, 2017 with E-Z Bel Construction, LLC, having submitted the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, this contract will be awarded in compliance with the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Program, with the Goal Setting Committee having set a 10% Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal, and E-Z Bel Construction, LLC, has committed to meeting this subcontracting goal; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance for the 2017 Traffic Signal Reconstruction Project accepts the lowest responsive bid and awards a contract to E-Z Bel Construction, LLC, for a one-time capital improvement expenditure in the amount of \$950,728.80, payable to E-Z Bel Construction, LLC, a FY 2017 Infrastructure Management Program (IMP) funded project; and

WHEREAS, funds are available from the FY 2017 General Fund Budget as part of the FY 2017 Traffic Signal Infrastructure Management Program (IMP); **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of **E-Z Bel Construction, LLC**, in the total amount not to exceed \$950,728.80, for the 2017 Traffic Signal Reconstruction Project, is hereby approved. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.


SECTION 2. A contract is hereby awarded to **E-Z Bel Construction, LLC**.

SECTION 3. A Payment in an amount not to exceed \$950,728.80 in SAP Fund 40099000, Other Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-01536, FY 2017 Traffic Signal Installation, is authorized to be encumber and make payable to **E-Z Bel Construction, LLC**, for construction services.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
