

AN ORDINANCE 2015-12-10-1045

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE EASTPOINT ARTIST RESIDENCIES OUR TOWN GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.00 FROM THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ANY NECESSARY AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts (“NEA”) has awarded the City the EastPoint Artist Residencies Our Town Grant, in the amount of \$100,000.00, for the period of October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2017, in which the City’s Department for Culture and Creative Development is partnering with the United Way Eastside Promise Area for City/Bexar County, a non-profit entity, to provide artist residencies in the EastPoint Promise Zone that will include community engagement and public art activities that utilize creative placemaking techniques that build communities and restore civic pride through the arts; and

WHEREAS, the NEA offers the Our Town Creative Placemaking grant program to support projects that help to transform communities into lively, beautiful, and resilient places with the arts at their core; and

WHEREAS, this grant will fund activities that include a series of educational, informative workshops that will bring local and visiting artists and planners together to discuss community-based public art projects that transform and revitalize communities and will be followed by three public artist residencies within the Eastside Promise Zone neighborhood; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The acceptance of the EastPoint Artist Residencies Our Town Grant from the NEA, in the amount of \$100,000.00 for the period October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2017, is authorized and approved. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute any necessary agreements to accept and administer this grant.

SECTION 2. The budget is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.


SECTION 3. The financial fiscal allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective ten days after its passage.


