**A RESOLUTION**

**IN SUPPORT OF THE RESERVE AT THOUSAND OAKS MULTI-  
FAMILY PROJECT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF  
HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR COMPETITIVE 9%  
HOUSING TAX CREDITS.**

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**WHEREAS**, SA The Reserve At Thousand Oaks, L.P. has proposed a development for affordable rental housing at 4500 Thousand Oaks Drive, to be known as The Reserve At Thousand Oaks, in the City of San Antonio, Council District 10; and

**WHEREAS**, SA The Reserve At Thousand Oaks, L.P. has advised that it intends to submit an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (“TDHCA”) for 2018 Competitive 9% Housing Tax Credits for The Reserve At Thousand Oaks; **NOW, THEREFORE:**

**BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City, acting through its governing body, hereby confirms that it supports SA The Reserve At Thousand Oaks, L.P.’s 9% tax credit application for The Reserve At Thousand Oaks, located at 4500 Thousand Oaks Drive, San Antonio, Texas 78233, TDHCA #18165, and that this formal action has been taken to put on record the opinion expressed by the City on February 8, 2018.

**SECTION 2.** For and on behalf of the City Council, the City Clerk is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to certify this Resolution to the TDHCA.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
