AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING TWO AGREEMENTS RELATED TO THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT'S TUBERCULOSIS PREVENTION AND CONTROL PROGRAM WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER AT TYLER IN A CUMULATIVE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$417,973.00 FOR PHYSICIAN SERVICES FOR A PERIOD ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2016 WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW.

WHEREAS, as the local health department for the City of San Antonio and Bexar County, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) is charged with investigating all suspected and confirmed cases of active tuberculosis (TB) and provides prompt diagnosis and treatment through a process of Directly Observed Therapy; and

WHEREAS, the University of Texas Health Science Center at Tyler (UTHSCT) is one of five Regional Training and Medical Consultation Centers in the United States, and is the only one in Texas funded by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention's Division of TB Elimination, to provide medical and technical consultation services related to various aspects of TB control; and

WHEREAS, as such, UTHSCT is the only entity with this level of expertise available within the state to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, through one agreement, Metro Health seeks to secure expert TB physician services through the UTHSCT for full medical coverage for all active TB patients referred to Metro Health's TB clinic; and

WHEREAS, the other agreement UTHSCT will provide TB physician services for the Texas Department of State Health Services' Tuberculosis Prevention Identification and Treatment Project under the Texas Medicaid 1115 Waiver for high risk individuals identified as having latent tuberculosis infection through increased targeted TB testing; and

WHEREAS, the agreements with UTHSCT will allow Metro Health to better facilitate treatment for individuals with suspect latent tuberculosis infection and active TB disease; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) or his designee is authorized to execute two agreements related to

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the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's Tuberculosis Prevention and Control Program with the University of Texas Health Science Center at Tyler (UTHSCT) in a cumulative amount of up to \$417,973.00 for physician services for the period ending September 30, 2016 with options to renew. A copy of the agreements in substantially final form are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachments I and II.**

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$128,500.00 for this ordinance is available for Fund 11001000, Cost Center 3616010003 and General Ledger 5201040, as part of the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget.

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to UTHSCT and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The sum of \$289,473.00 is appropriated in fund 2601636128 and Internal Order 136000000623 and will be disbursed from GL 5201040. Payment is authorized to UTHSCT upon issuance of a purchase order.

SECTION 5. Future funding through the renewal terms of these agreements are contingent upon City Council approval of subsequent fiscal year budgets.

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
