Background of San Antonio Conservation Society



Founded in 1924 , the San Antonio Conservation Society (SACS), is one of the oldest and most active community preservation groups in the US

Purpose of SACS is to preserve the history of Texas and educate the public with knowledge of inherited regional values

SACS has selected to support the pump house restoration project which exemplifies their contribution to the preservation and restoration of San Antonio's rich historic fabric

This project will assist in the restoration and rehabilitation of the 1877 water works pump house

Background Historic Pump House No. 1



Located on the San Antonio River at the north end of Brackenridge Park


Built in the late 1800's as part of the City's original waterworks

One of the City's oldest existing industrial buildings

This project is aligned with the adopted Brackenridge Park Master Plan

Funding Agreement

- One-time contribution of \$300,000
- Payments made in three (3) annual installments of \$100,000
- Term: Upon execution, terminating upon substantial completion of the project
