Hagner Arc Closure and Conveyance


Summary

Ordinance Authorizing:

- A. Closing, vacating, and abandoning a total of 0.368 acres of right of way of Hagner Arc right-of-way located between Convent Street and Navarro Street and of Convent Street.
- B. Conveying a total of 0.368 acres to Convent Ventures, L.P. and 1 Riverwalk, LLC and accepting an in-kind contribution of approximately \$570,085 towards the value of the proposed closure fee.
- C. Negotiation and execution of a Storm Water Agreement with Convent Ventures, L.P. and 1 Riverwalk, LLC to cap and abandon an existing storm drain and provide up to \$94,200 from available funds in the FY 2018 Storm Water Utility Fund.

Background

- In December 2017, Council approved a \$4 million Chapter 380
 Agreement with USAA, to facilitate a \$70 million investment and addition of 1,500 new full-time jobs
- USAA's investment requires an expansion of the parking garage at One Riverwalk Place.
- USAA shall also provide \$570,085 in Public Improvements including Riverwalk entry, sidewalk, lighting, street striping, and a new storm drain easement










Issue

- The closure and conveyance of Hagner Arc and a small portion of Convent St. right of way is required.
- The abutting property owners have executed an Agreement and consent to closure and conveyance.
- The relocation of an existing failing storm drain without an easement is necessary.
- This action will allow the property to be placed on the tax rolls, generating revenue for the City of San Antonio and other taxing entities.



Recommendation

Staff recommends an Ordinance authorizing:

- A. Closing, vacating, and abandoning a total of 0.368 acres of right of way of Hagner Arc right-of-way located between Convent Street and Navarro Street and of Convent Street.
- B. Conveying a total of 0.368 acres to Convent Ventures, L.P. and 1 Riverwalk, LLC and accepting an in-kind contribution of approximately \$570,085 towards the value of the proposed closure fee.
- C. Negotiation and execution of a Storm Water Agreement with Convent Ventures, L.P. and 1 Riverwalk, LLC to cap and abandon an existing storm drain and provide up to \$94,200 from available funds in the FY 2018 Storm Water Utility Fund.
