

AN ORDINANCE 2013 - 12 - 05 - 0872

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF \$1,114,076.00 IN TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE “BICYCLE SAFE RESOURCES FOR 8 TO 80-YEAR-OLDS” AND THE “B-CYCLE URBAN CORE EXPANSION” PROJECTS, APPROVING LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS, AND THE NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR EACH PROJECT

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2012-11-08-0876, authorized the submission of grant applications to the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for federal funds associated with the Transportation Enhancement Program including two projects managed by the Office of Sustainability, “Bicycle Safe Resources for 8 to 80-year-olds” and “B-Cycle Urban Core Expansion”; and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2013 the City of San Antonio was notified by TxDOT that funding was being provided to fund the two projects, which are eligible for reimbursement of up to 80% of allowable costs, to further the goals of San Antonio as a bicycle-friendly community that promotes and supports alternative transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City must execute Advance Funding Agreements with TxDOT and will receive grant funds of \$1,114,076.00 for the two projects; the City will provide \$278,519.00 in local matching funds, for a total cost for both projects of \$1,392,586.00; the City will also provide \$18,164.00 to fund 20% of the TxDOT Direct State Costs; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes the acceptance and appropriation of funds from the TxDOT Transportation Enhancement Program grant in the amount of \$1,114,076.00 for the implementation of the “Bicycle Safe Resources for 8 to 80-year-olds” and the “B-Cycle Urban Core Expansion” projects, approves local matching funds and authorizes the negotiation and execution of Advance Funding Agreements with TxDOT for each project; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director, Office of Sustainability (OS), or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate TxDOT Transportation Enhancement Program grant funds in the amount of \$1,114,076.00, for the implementation of the “Bicycle Safe Resources for 8 to 80-year-olds” and the “B-Cycle Urban Core Expansion” projects, and to take all actions necessary to negotiate and execute an Advance Funding Agreement with TxDOT for each project. Local cash matching funds are hereby authorized and approved in the amounts of \$28,520.00 from the Advanced Transportation District Funds and \$249,999.00 from the City’s Energy Efficiency Fund.

SECTION 2. Fund 2605955003 entitled "TxDOT Bicycle Safe" and Fund 2605955004 entitled "TxDOT Bicycle UrbCor" are hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant. The sum of \$114,080.00 and \$999,996.00 from TxDOT will be appropriated in the above designated funds, respectively. The sum of \$28,520.00 and \$249,999.00 cash match will also be appropriated in the above designated funds, respectively.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.


