## Federal Budget



2 year budget passed February 9

Defense spending: \$165 B

Domestic spending: \$131 B





## FY 2018 Appropriations



- FY18 appropriations bill signed into law March 23
- Overall a good spending package for the military and Cities
- Funds federal government through September 30

## FY 2018 Appropriations Highlights



- HHS: \$9.9B for Head Start (up \$610M)
   City receives about \$23M annually
- FEMA: \$630 for UASI, (up \$25M)
  City received \$1.5M in 2018
- DOJ: \$2.9B for State & Local Grants, \$275M for COPS Hiring, (up \$54M)
   City received \$3.1M in 2017
- HUD: \$3.3B for CDBG (up \$300M) and \$1.4B for HOME (up \$412M)

City received approximately \$10.9 million in CDBG funds and \$4.8 million in HOME funds in 2018

- February 12,FY 2019 President's proposed budget released
- Congressional process in progress at House &
   Senate committee level

### **FAA Reauthorization**



House passage on May 26

Senate deliberations on-going
 Possible floor time in July or August



FAA Deadline is September 30

### DACA





- March 5 Deadline set by President's Executive Order
- January/February Two judges from California & New York block ending of DACA
- February 26 U.S. Supreme Court declined to hear the Trump administration's appeal of a lower court ruling
- February 15 Failed Senate vote
- June 12 Failed House Discharge Petition to force House Floor vote

### **NAFTA**





- Negotiations on-going
- Speaker Ryan set un-official deadline of early June for vote on final deal
- Congressional Outlook to 2019

## Air Quality Designation Status



- Designations under 2015 NAAQS originally expected Fall 2017
- December 21, 2017 EPA publishes notice designating Texas counties in nonattainment. No decision on San Antonio MSA
- March 14, 2018 Court orders EPA to publish final designation for Bexar MSA counties by July 17
- March 18, 2018 EPA letter to Governor indicating an "at best" unclassifiable designation for Bexar County
