AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE DESIGNATION OF A RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE ON PORTIONS OF PERRY COURT IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2.

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WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio created a Residential Only Parking Permit Program through Ordinance 2015-04-30-0359; and

WHEREAS, residents have submitted a petition for the creation of Residential Permit Parking Zone on certain public rights of way; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of this residential permit parking zone will provide a public benefit to the residents whose property fronts certain public rights of way; and

WHEREAS, unnecessary noise, pollution and strained relationships between neighborhood residents and non-residents will be reduced in the zone resulting in an increase of safety, tranquility, aesthetics and other values available in this residential environment; **NOW THEREFORE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. A Residential Permit Parking Zone is hereby created for the areas of Perry Court identified on **Exhibit I**. Permit parking hours shall be weekdays between 7am-7pm. A permit is not required at any other time.

SECTION 2. Funds generated by this ordinance will be deposited into Fund 53001000, Internal Order 219000000129 and General Ledger 4403138.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance becomes effective 10 days after passage, unless it receives the eight votes requisite to immediate effectiveness under San Antonio Municipal Code § 1-15, in which case it becomes effective immediately.

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EXHIBIT I

Residential area in red defines the RPP Zone. 30' from Broadway on either side will be restricted because of proximity to intersection. Area in yellow will allow for public parking.
