

**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING APPOINTMENTS TO THE  
CITIZEN ADVISORY ACTION BOARD.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 of Article 29 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of San Antonio, Texas and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association, passed and approved by San Antonio City Council on September 1, 2016, the San Antonio City Council must select persons from a list of applicants provided by the City Manager to serve as members of the Citizen Advisory Action Board (CAAB); and

**WHEREAS**, there are currently five vacancies on the CAAB, which is composed of fourteen persons, and which hears investigations on complaints made against police officers for misconduct, use of force and violation of the San Antonio Police Department General Manual; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of appointments on the CAAB will be for a two year period, beginning the effective date of this ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, applicants were interviewed by a four-person panel, which consisted of Deputy City Manager Erik Walsh, Chief of Police William McManus, Assistant City Attorney Elizabeth Provencio and Captain Brian Reyes, and the City Manager and Chief of Police recommend each of the persons listed in Section 1 of this Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the list of recommended appointees is representative of the diversity of the community, in that the list includes four females and one male, and is comprised of two Hispanics, one Caucasian, one African-American and one Asian/Pacific islander; and

**WHEREAS**, input and recommendation of the San Antonio Police Officers' Association shall be obtained as to the recommended appointees; and

**WHEREAS**, those on said list must meet the minimum qualifications established by Subsection 143.006(c) of the Texas Local Government Code for service on the San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager submitted such a list and all of those on that list meet the minimum qualifications; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The following persons are hereby selected and appointed to serve as members on the CAAB:

1. Nadia Islam
2. Jesus Diaz
3. Judy Razo
4. Dr. Anika Smith
5. Shelley Baillargeon

**SECTION 2.** The service of said members on the CAAB shall begin when this ordinance takes effect, and shall be for a term of two years.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
