**A RESOLUTION**

**IDENTIFYING ROOSEVELT PLACE APARTMENTS AS  
CONTRIBUTING MORE THAN ANY OTHER TO THE CONCERTED  
REVITALIZATION EFFORTS OF THE MUNICIPALITY IN THE  
ROOSEVELT-MISSION REACH NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT  
AREA.**

**WHEREAS**, ACG Roosevelt has proposed a development (the “Development”) for affordable rental housing at 2800 Roosevelt Avenue, to be known as Roosevelt Place Apartments, in the City of San Antonio, Council District 3; and

**WHEREAS**, ACG Roosevelt has advised that it intends to submit an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (“TDHCA”) for 2018 Competitive 9% Housing Tax Credits for the Development; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 8, 2018, the City Council approved a resolution of local government in support of the Development; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has identified that the Development is located within the Roosevelt-Mission Reach Neighborhood Improvement Area, a distinct area within San Antonio Urban Renewal Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council finds that the Development contributes more than any other to the concerted revitalization efforts of the City to the designated area; **NOW, THEREFORE:**

**BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO  
THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City hereby identifies Roosevelt Place Apartments as the development in the 2018 Competitive 9% Housing Tax Credits round that contributes more than any other to the concerted revitalization efforts of the City in the Roosevelt-Mission Reach Neighborhood Improvement Area.

**SECTION 2.** For and on behalf of the City Council, the City Clerk is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to certify this Resolution to the TDHCA.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
