## **Department of Human Services Head Start Program**

### **1303.44 Major Renovations Application**

#### **Program Year 2021-2022**

#### **Project Description**

The City of San Antonio, Department of Human Services, Head Start Program (heretofore, DHS Head Start) will submit a major renovation application as allowed under section 1303.44 of the Head Start Performance Standards. This application will request to utilize previously approved American Rescue Plan (ARPA) funds to make renovations and improvements to the DHS Head Start Brady Building located at 1227 Brady Boulevard, San Antonio, TX 78207. Because this building was purchased with federal funds, there is federal interest in the building. A request for a major renovation requires that a thorough cost analysis be completed to determine that the renovation is the best course of action. We have worked with both our CoSA real estate department as well as an external realtor to make this determination and feel confident that making these repairs is the most cost-effective option.

The repairs are necessary to safely resume and maintain full in-person program operations. DHS will improve the plumbing system that is over 35 years old; grade and repave the entire parking lot pavement to allow for proper water run-off away from the building; and repair a structural beam displaced due incorrect water runoff which will be corrected by grading the parking lot. With these repairs, DHS can ensure that the Head Start Brady Building does not pose health or safety concerns to staff and families who work and or visit the facility. The project cost estimate is \$752,000.00. This includes the total construction and soft costs, as well as permits, fees, and contingency.
