The purpose of the \$25,000 will be used to support the Northeast Corridor Revitalization (NEC) project in District 10. The funds will be used for Binding and Printing of Mailers and Marketing Materials to promote the revitalization effort and attract new businesses to the area. Other potential uses for the funds will be used for corridor improvements that include Landscape Design, Tree Planting and other qualifying amenities that will help to improve the Perrin Beitel/Nacogdoches corridor.

Funding will be managed by the Northeast Corridor Revitalization Manager and use the funds as directed by the Steering Committee that is made up of five individuals who represent the business leaders and neighborhood representatives.
