

AN ORDINANCE **2014 - 11 - 13 - 0913**

**ACCEPTING \$1,515,000.00 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE  
TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION OVER FIVE  
YEARS COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2015 FOR CONTINUED  
PARTICIPATION IN THE NATIONAL EXPLOSIVES DETECTION  
CANINE TEAM PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, in May 2008, the City entered into a five-year reimbursement grant agreement with the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) for the City to provide explosives detection training for canines and personnel at San Antonio International Airport and for the TSA to provide reimbursement of certain operating expenses per canine team plus a stipend; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2012-08-02-0554 approved on August 2, 2012 authorized acceptance of additional grant funds from TSA for continued participation in the National Explosives Detection Canine Team Program; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to accept reimbursement in the amount of \$50,500.00 per canine team annually for up to \$1,515,000.00 in grant funds from the TSA over five years commencing January 1, 2015 in order to continue participation in the National Explosives Detection Canine Team Program; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Aviation Department is hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$50,500.00 per canine team annually for up to \$1,515,000.00 from the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) for continued participation in the National Explosives Detection Canine Team Program at the San Antonio International Airport for five years with an effective date of January 1, 2015.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or the Aviation Director is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents and take any actions necessary to effect said acceptance.

**SECTION 3.** Fund 26065000 entitled "Homeland Security" is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant. The sum of \$50,500.00 per canine team annually for up to \$1,515,000.00 from the TSA will be appropriated in said fund. A final budget will be provided upon acceptance of funds.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP

Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage by eight (8) affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective ten (10) days after its passage.


