

AN ORDINANCE 2015-03-12-0185

**ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE QUALIFIED
BID AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$479,000.00 TO CGC GENERAL
CONTRACTORS, INC., FOR THE SOUTHSIDE LIONS
PARK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, A 2012-2017 BOND-
FUNDED PROJECT, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 3.**

* * * * *

WHEREAS, under the voter approved 2012-2017 Bond Program, \$87.15 million was allocated for Parks, Recreation and Open Space Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Bond Program funds will be used on various capital improvement projects to address community infrastructure needs and improve the overall quality of life in San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, as part of that program, funds in the total amount of \$750,000.00 in Parks, Recreation and Open Space Improvements Bond funds were approved for park improvements at Southside Lions Park, located in Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, the balance of the Project funds approved by voters will be used for design services, environmental services, advertising and project management, with any funds remaining to be realized as bond savings; and

WHEREAS, Southside Lions Park improvements provide for the construction of a 17 vehicle parking lot with 610 linear feet of associated concrete sidewalk with picnic units and trash/recycle receptacles, toilet enclosure and landscaping as well as a .52 Mile concrete walking trail complete with rest areas and trash receptacles linking the Community Center on the west side of the park with the Lake on the east; and

WHEREAS, these improvements will open up an area of the park for public use and improve accessibility between the Community Center and the Lake. Project construction is anticipated to begin in March 2015 and estimated to be completed by August 2015; and

WHEREAS, this project was advertised for construction bids in the San Antonio Hart Beat, on the City's website, on the Texas Electronic State Business Daily, on TVSA and through the TCI Small Business Office; and

WHEREAS, plans also were available for review by potential bidders at the office of Rehler Vaughn & Koone, Inc., located at 745 East Mulberry, San Antonio, TX 78212; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on January 13, 2015 and two (2) bids were received; and

WHEREAS, of these, CGC General Contractors, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive qualified bid; and

WHEREAS, this contract will be awarded in compliance with the new Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Program, which requires contracts to be reviewed by a Goal Setting Committee to establish a requirement and/or incentive unique to the particular contract in an effort to maximize the amount of small, minority and women-owned business participation on the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Goal Setting Committee set a 13% Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal and a 2% African-American Business Enterprise (AABE) subcontracting goal; and

WHEREAS, CGC General Contractors, Inc. has committed to 14% M/WBE and 2.5% AABE subcontractor participation; and

WHEREAS, CGC General Contractors, Inc. is also a certified small business; and

WHEREAS, this construction contract was developed utilizing the low bid process; therefore, a Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Form is not required; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive qualified bid in the amount of \$479,000.00 from CGC General Contractors, Inc., for the Southside Lions Park Improvements Project is hereby accepted. The contract described herein shall become effective upon the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates so long as such deposits are accomplished within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this ordinance. A copy of the contractor's executed Formal Invitation for Bids and Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount of \$479,000.00 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Project, SAP Project Definition 40-00393, Southside Lions Park, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to the CGC General Contractors, Inc., for construction services.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
