Traffic signal controllers and conflict monitors are electronic devices installed at all signalized intersections to store and process the traffic signal functions.

<b>Procurement Alternative:</b>	Should this contract not be approved, the Transportation and Capital Improvements Department, Traffic Division will be required to procure materials on an as needed basis. The City could lose the pricing advantage afforded through a competitively bid contract. While the traffic signal control equipment may be purchased individually, the department's budget could be negatively impacted through continuous price variations.
