**A RESOLUTION**

**IN SUPPORT OF NATIONAL CHURCH RESIDENCES OF BLANCO  
ROAD MULTI-FAMILY PROJECT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS  
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR  
COMPETITIVE 9% HOUSING TAX CREDITS.**

**WHEREAS**, Blanco Senior Housing Limited Partnership has proposed a development for affordable rental housing at 19480 Blanco Road, to be known as National Church Residences of Blanco Road, in the City of San Antonio, Council District 9; and

**WHEREAS**, Blanco Senior Housing Limited Partnership has advised that it intends to submit an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (“TDHCA”) for 2018 Competitive 9% Housing Tax Credits for National Church Residences of Blanco Road; **NOW, THEREFORE:**

**BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City, acting through its governing body, hereby confirms that it supports Blanco Senior Housing Limited Partnership’s 9% tax credit application for National Church Residences of Blanco Road, located at 19480 Blanco Road, San Antonio, Texas 78258, TDHCA #18121, and that this formal action has been taken to put on record the opinion expressed by the City on February 8, 2018.

**SECTION 2.** For and on behalf of the City Council, the City Clerk is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to certify this Resolution to the TDHCA.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
