The San Antonio Police Department is seeking grant funds not to exceed the amount of \$1,000,000.00 from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the Comprehensive Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) for the grant period October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020. Due to the Holiday schedules and that the solicitation date of the STEP FY 20 grant, November 13, 2018, there is not enough time to get City Council approval to apply and accept. Therefore, we have to use the Special Category Grant Opportunity Submission Authorization Request process in order to apply for funding on or before January 10, 2019.
