High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Grant Program

- Grant Period: January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2019
- Total Budget: \$1,988,146
- No Cash Match
- Ordinance authorizes submission and acceptance up to \$1,988,146 from ONDCP Agency

HIDTA History

- 25th year that ONDCP has offered SAPD this grant
 - Fiscal Year 2017 \$2,053,110, which included discretionary funds of \$67,040.
 - Fiscal Year 2018 anticipated award is \$1,988,146, which does not include discretionary funding.
 - Fiscal Year 2018 Funds 17 positions
- Mission: to reduce drug trafficking in the San Antonio metropolitan area by instituting innovative narcotic enforcement investigations and seizing illegally obtained assets in an effort to reduce the profitability of narcotics trafficking.
