AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE **EXECUTION OF (1)** CONTRABAND FORFEITURE AGREEMENT AND (2) A CONTRABAND **FORFEITURE AGREEMENT** GAMBLING PROPERTY AND PROCEEDS, BOTH WITH THREE-YEAR TERMS COMMENCING APRIL 1, 2014. WITH THE BEXAR COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S PROCEEDS FROM **OFFICE** TO **SHARE** FORFEITURE CASES PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 18 AND 59 OF THE TEXAS CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio (COSA) and the Bexar County District Attorney's Office (BCDAO) are authorized to enter into interlocal agreements for the division of the proceeds of assets forfeited pursuant to Chapters 18 and 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure; and

WHEREAS, the COSA and the BCDAO wish to enter into two interlocal agreements, one addressing asset forfeiture cases involving other than gambling, the Contraband Forfeiture Agreement, and the other addressing asset forfeiture cases involving gambling, the Contraband Forfeiture Agreement for Gambling Property and Proceeds; and

WHEREAS, both agreements will commence April 1, 2014, and end March 30, 2019; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to execute a Contraband Forfeiture Agreement and a Contraband Forfeiture Agreement for Gambling Property and Proceeds, both with a term commencing April 14, 2014, and ending March 30, 2019, with the BCDAO to provide for the division of the proceeds of assets forfeited pursuant to Chapters 18 and 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure. The terms and conditions of said agreements, which are attached hereto as **Exhibit I** and **Exhibit II**, respectively, are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. FINANCE LANGUAGE TO BE ADDED.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
