This contract will provide various City departments with the purchase and delivery of electrolyte replacement drink in both ready-to-drink and powder varieties. This drink will be utilized by City employees to help maintain correct electrolyte balance while working in hot and/or humid conditions or when manual labor produces loss of electrolytes. The powder mix (electrolyte replacement drink) is utilized by the Public Works, Solid Waste and BES Departments. The bottled electrolyte replacement drink is utilized by the Fire Department and approved by the Tool & Equipment committee for both the SAFD firefighters and EMS Paramedics.
