AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A TOTAL OF FIVE AGREEMENTS WITH INC., **AVANCE-SAN** ANTONIO, **FAMILY SERVICE** ASSOCIATION, PARENT CHILD INCORPORATED AND THE SOUTH SAN ANTONIO ISD FOR THE PERIOD OF FEBRUARY 1, 2016 TO JANUARY 31, 2017 FOR THE PROVISION OF ORAL **HEALTH SERVICES** BY THE SAN **ANTONIO** METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT TO EARLY HEAD START AND HEAD START ENROLLEES WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR TERMS FOR A CUMULATIVE AMOUNT, INCLUSIVE OF RENEWALS, OF UP TO \$399,000.00 AND AN IN-KIND MATCH REQUIREMENT IN SERVICES TOTALING \$79,800.00.

WHEREAS, on an annual basis, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) Dental Program provides diagnostic and preventive care to more than 12,000 children living in poverty by providing services in non-traditional settings, such as Head Start, and on campuses of local Title I elementary schools; and

WHEREAS, through these programs, many children are identified with additional dental treatment needs beyond the scope of Metro Health services; and

WHEREAS, case management services are provided by Metro Health dental staff to assist participating children to receive needed treatment and to connect families to a source of ongoing care in the community; and

WHEREAS, approximately 23% of children enrolled in the City's Head Start Program are not covered through Texas Medicaid or the Children's Health Insurance Plan; and

WHEREAS, during the 2010-2011 school year more than 1,850 children that were enrolled in the program were identified with untreated decay; and

WHEREAS, through dental services agreements with AVANCE-San Antonio, Inc., Family Service Association, Parent Child Incorporated and the South San Antonio ISD Metro Health will provide oral health assessments and preventive care, including fluoride varnish applications, for children enrolled in the Early Head Start and the Head Start Program; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or his designee is authorized to execute a total of five agreements with AVANCE-San Antonio Inc., Family Service Association, Parent Child, Incorporated and South San Antonio ISD for the period of February 1, 2016 to January 31, 2017 for the provision of oral health services by the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District to Early Head Start and Head Start enrollees with options to renew for two additional one-year terms for a cumulative amount, inclusive of renewals, of up to \$399,000.00. An in-kind match requirement in services totaling \$79,800.00 is authorized. Copies of the agreements, in substantially final form, are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I - V**.

SECTION 2. Funds generated by this ordinance will be deposited into Fund 29836000 and General Ledger 4502280, Internal Order number to be created.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
