AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CITY AND COUNTY HEALTH OFFICIALS AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00 FOR THE ALAMO AREA MEDICAL RESERVE CORPS FOR A TERM BEGINNING JANUARY 5, 2014 TO JULY 31, 2014.

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WHEREAS, the Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) is a nationally recognized organization that is housed under the Office of the Surgeon General; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Alamo Area MRC is to recruit, train and coordinate volunteers whether medical or non-medical professionals, to respond to all-hazard events in South Central Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Alamo Area MRC has been housed locally under the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) Public Health Emergency Preparedness Division (PHEP) for the past four years and consists of medical and non-medical volunteers from our community who are trained to assist in times of emergencies; and

WHEREAS, MRC volunteers could be called upon to assist with public health and natural disaster response activities, such as hurricanes, H1N1 and could also be used in the event of a terroristic attack; and

WHEREAS, to date, the Alamo Area MRC has provided assistance at Health Fairs throughout the City of San Antonio and in responding to H1N1; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) or his designee is authorized to submit a grant application to the National Association of City and County Health Officials (NACCHO) and accept funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 for the Alamo Area Medical Reserve Corps for a term beginning January 5, 2014 to July 31, 2014. A copy of the grant application which is incorporated herein for all purposes is on file with Metro Health.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or his designee is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance of funds.

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SECTION 3. Should funding be awarded, Fund 26012000 entitled "Misc Grants" is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant and the sum of \$5,000.00 from the NACCHO will be appropriated in said fund. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I** is approved and adopted for entry in the City books. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
