**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION, AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS UPON AWARD, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,500,000.00 TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION JUSTICE, FOR THE RIFLE-RESISTANT BODY ARMOR GRANT PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD, has grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000.00 for the purchase of rifle-resistant body armor, including bullet proof vests, ballistic plates, and plate carriers; and

**WHEREAS**, currently, our officers whose primary duties include patrol functions who are most likely to encounter rifle armed perpetrators are not equipped with rifle-resistant body armor; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of the grant funds requires the San Antonio Police Department to provide written policy on the use and care of rifle-resistant body armor purchased with grant funds prior to submitting the grant to CJD; and

**WHEREAS**, no cash or in-kind matching contribution is required; and

**WHEREAS**, this is a 12 month project that must begin between January 1 and March 1, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the final date to submit an application for the program is on September 6, 2017;  
**NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to submit a grant application in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000.00 to the CJD for funds that will be used to purchase rifle-resistant body armor, ballistic plates, and plate carriers. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under substantially the same terms and conditions as applied for. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which a sum not to exceed \$1,500,000.00 will be appropriated from the CJD. The proposed budget attached hereto as **Attachment I** is hereby approved.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
