


<p><b>Summer Food Service Program</b> - This application will allow the continuation of the Summer Food Service Program that has provided free nutritional meals to children age eighteen and below in our community during the summer months since 1969. The program will enable food delivery services to over 6,000 children at over 68 sites, with maximum capacity to serve over 254,000 lunches and 261,000 snacks throughout the summer in conjunction with the Department's Summer Youth Programs and other city-wide non-profit organizations including the YWCA and faith based organizations. Selrico Services, Inc., was selected through a competitive process in March 2020 to provide these services and is in the first year of a five-year agreement. Parks and Recreation staff coordinated with Metro Health to ensure a Por Vida designated healthy menu again this year.</p>
