Michael Taylor spoke in support of staff's recommendation to restore \$1 million in CDBG funding.

Brad McMurray expressed support for redirecting funds from the EHAP to affordable housing.

James Dykman stated that the only way to negotiate a new contract that would protect citizens and officers was to repeal collective bargaining rights and negotiate a new contract that promoted accountability.

Ananda Tomas urged city leaders to refocus on collective bargaining negotiations. She noted that police reform was a priority for many voters and contract negotiations must be transparent.
