 - City: \$998,000
 - FAA: \$2.55M

 Submission of a grant application & acceptance of funds for a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant for \$2.55M.

A: WSP USA Agreement

Phase I - \$3.6M

- Stakeholder Engagement, Existing Conditions, Aviation Forecasts, Facility Requirements – 75% FAA/25% City
- Update 2012 Economic Impact Study 100% City

Refine Phase II Scope

- Incorporate Key Stakeholder Input to help define Phase II
 - Airport System Development Committee, Stakeholder Working Group, Technical Advisory Committee, Transportation & Planning Partners Working Group, & Public Engagement

Phase II

- Stakeholder Engagement, Airport Alternatives, Airport Layout Plan, Facilities Implementation Plan/CIP, Financial Feasibility – 75% FAA/25% City
- Noise Exposure Map 80% FAA/20% City

B: AIP Grant Item







- The FAA participates in the funding of its update as it serves as the planning document for airfield/airport projects.
 - FAA: 75%
 - City: 25%
- This action will submit a grant in the amount up to \$2.55 million and accept the grant funds from the FAA.
